

President Randy 3 CB Radio Service Menu Information

How to enter the menu:

1. Ensure the Radio is turned off.
2. Press and hold the [ANL/NB] button.
3. Press and hold the [Scan] button.
4. Turn the Radio on and release depressed buttons.
5. Use the [Up] and [Down] channel selection buttons to move between options.
6. Press and hold the [PTT] button and use the [Up] and [Down] channel selection buttons to change values.
7. Remember that lowering the values for power increases the power output! 😊

Menu options and values:

Option	CH	Information
PWR-HI **	05	FM Expanded High-Power Adjustment [My standard value = 02-78] ** only available when the radio is expanded / modified and powered from the car kit**
PWR-MI **	06	FM Standard High-Power Adjustment [My standard value = 03-07] ** high power mode in un-expanded mode and when running on battery**
PWR-LO	07	FM Low Power Adjustment [My standard value = 03-42]
FM-MOD	09	FM Modulation [My standard value = 05-11]
AM-LO	13	AM LP Amplitude Adjustment [My standard value = 00-89] Ensure AM channel selected. 1.25K – 30mV. Adjust to 88% This is amplitude adjustment not power. If you don't have the appropriate equipment to test leave this alone.
AM-HI	14	AM HP Amplitude Adjustment [My standard value = 01-08] Ensure AM channel selected. 1.25K – 30mV. Adjust to 86%. This is amplitude adjustment not power. If you don't have the appropriate equipment to test leave this alone.
VER	21	Version number displayed VER122 = 1.22 In expanded mode VER122E = 1.22Expanded
